Petitioner has prayed for a writ in the nature of mandamus to direct the respondents to measure his height afresh for the purpose of determining his merit. A copy of the petition was handed over to State counsel on the last date of hearing. Today, she, on instructions from Gurinder Singh, Clerk from the office of ADGP, Prisons, Punjab, submits that petitioner signed on the said document after height measurement. There is nothing on record to show that height of the petitioner is more than that has been mentioned at the time of selection. In the absence of any evidence to the contrary, this court does not intend to interfere in the writ jurisdiction to direct measurement of height of the petitioner afresh. Petition is without any merit and is hereby dismissed.
