The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.154 dated 19.12.2018 registered for the offences punishable under Sections 406, 498-A, 354 of Indian Penal Code, at Police Station Women, District Police Commissionerate, Ludhiana.

Heard.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that a compromise has been effected between the parties and as per compromise, FDR for ₹ 5.5 lacs for a period of one year has been brought in Court today which has been handed over to Ms. Bharti who is present in Court. It is stated that FDR for another sum of ₹ 5.5 lacs will be given when the parties will prefer a petition under Section 13-B of Hindu Marriage Act.

merits of the case, this petition is allowed and the order dated 26.2.2019 is made absolute till the presentation of challan, subject to the following terms:-

- (i) that the petitioner shall make himself available for interrogation as and when required by the police;
- (ii) that the petitioner shall not, directly or indirectly, make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the accusation against him so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer;
- (iii) that the petitioner shall not leave India without the prior permission of the trial Court.
- (iv) that the petitioner will seek regular bail on the presentation of challan in Court.
