The petitioner seeks grant of regular bail in case FIR No.18, dated 27.12.2018, registered under Section 7 read with Section 13(2) of the Prevention of Corruption Act, at Police Station Vigilance Bureau, District Amritsar.

Counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner has now been in custody for two months and the investigation is complete with the filing of the challan.

Learned DAG Punjab, on instructions from ASI Vipin Kumar, has accepted these factual assertions.

In these circumstances, without commenting upon the merits of the case, and keeping in view the period of custody already suffered by the petitioner, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of regular

bail to the petitioner.
