The instant petition has been filed by Samiyr Chander (minor) through mother and natural guardian seeking a Writ of Mandamus to the Central Board of Secondary Education (C.B.S.E) to carry out the correction in the 10th Class Pass Certificate and for the mother's name to read as Jagjit Kaur instead of Jagjeet Chander.

Counsel would place heavy reliance upon a communication dated 26.10.2018 (Annexure P-5) issued by the school in question i.e. Delhi Public School, Sector 40-C, Chandigarh and addressed to the Regional Officer, C.B.S.E, Sector 5, Panchkula and in terms of which the request for correction as noticed herein above had been forwarded by the school.

During the course of hearing counsel was put a specific query as to whether the correction as prayed for in the instant petition has been carried out in the school records. Counsel is unable to give any concrete response to the same.

Under such circumstances the prayer made in the instant petition cannot be accepted, at this stage.

In the considered view of this Court the petitioner ought to, in the first instance, approach the school in question for carrying out the necessary correction in the school records and thereafter carry the prayer forward to the C.B.S.E.
