Present petition under Section 439 of the Criminal Procedure Code is for grant of regular bail to petitioner- Sandeep Singh son of Balour Singh in case F.I.R. No.109 dated 10.07.2018 under Sections 324, 326 of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station City Sri Muktsar Sahib.

Learned counsel representing petitioner contended that the petitioner was arrested in this case after 53 days and has been falsely implicated in this case. Moreso, he is in custody since 03.09.2018 and the offences alleged against the petitioner are triable by the Court of Magistrate. The trial of the case still to take some more time and no useful purpose would be served by detaining the petitioner behind the bars, so he be released on bail.

Learned State counsel contended that the trial is almost at the fag end and no case is made out for release of the petitioner on regular bail.

At this stage, without commenting anything on the merits of the case, which may not cause prejudice to either of the parties at a later stage, but taking the above facts into consideration and the fact the petitioner is in custody since 03.09.2018, the offences alleged against the petitioner are triable by the Court of Magistrate; the trial of the case still to take some more time and no useful purpose would be served by detaining the petitioner behind the bars, the present petition is allowed. Petitioner—Sandeep Singh, is ordered to be admitted to regular bail on his furnishing adequate bail bond and surety bond to the satisfaction of concerned learned trial Judge/ Chief Judicial Magistrate/ Duty Magistrate.
