Petitioner has preferred the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.09 dated 09.01.2019, registered under Sections 363, 366-A, 506, 34 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 25 of Arms Act, 1959, at Police Station Gohana Sadar, District Sonipat.

FIR was lodged by the father of the prosecutrix on the basis of suspicion to the effect that her daughter has been kidnapped by Shivam and petitioner-Paramjit @ Pintu, who was the driver of the vehicle, on which both of them have fled away, but in the statement under Section 164 Cr.P.C., she has stated that her father and brother had beaten her, therefore, she left the house on her own.

Learned State counsel has stated that petitioner has joined the investigation; nothing is to be recovered from him and he is no more required for custodial interrogation.

In the circumstances, without going into the merits of the case, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in the present case. Ordered accordingly.

Resultantly, the interim order dated 11.02.2019, is made absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands allowed.
