This is a petition for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner under Section 438 Cr.P.C. in case FIR No.138 dated 31.12.2018 registered under Sections 379-B/186/332/353/427/148 read with 149 and 120-B IPC and Section 136 of Representation of People Act, 1951, 307 IPC and Sections 25-54/59 of Arms Act (added later on) at Police Station Khanauri, Sangrur.

The allegations against the petitioner are that he instigated an attack on a polling party during the conduct of Panchayat Elections. As per the FIR the petitioner was not present at the site.

Learned Deputy Advocate General on instructions from ASI
Sukhwinder Singh has accepted this fact.

In the circumstances, without going into the merits of the case, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner. Resultantly, the petition is allowed. In the event of arrest of the petitioner, he shall be released on bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating Officer subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.

The petitioner is directed to appear before the investigating officer on 25.02.2019 and on any other date as and when his presence is required.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
