Present petition has been filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure (for short 'Cr.P.C') for grant of pre arrest bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.0011 dated 10.01.2019, under Sections 379 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 and Section 4(1) of Mines and Minerals (Regulation of Development) Act, 1957, registered at Police Station Dera Bassi, District SAS Nagar (Punjab).

This court passed the following order on 15.02.2019:-

*“Learned State Counsel is not able to assist the Court as
Investigating Officer of the case is not present.*

Adjourned to 25.03.2019 for further consideration.

In the meanwhile, the petitioner is directed to join the investigation before the Investigating Officer. In the event of his arrest, the Arresting Officer would admit him to interim bail in the present case till the next date of hearing on his furnishing adequate bail and surety bonds to his satisfaction. The petitioner is also directed to abide by all the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

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Learned State Counsel, on instructions from HC Baldev Singh has acknowledged that in terms of the previous order the petitioner has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation is no longer required in this case.

In view of above, the interim order dated 15.02.2019 is made absolute, subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. and the present petition stands disposed off.
