The grievance of the petitioner is that a raid was conducted by respondents No.5 to 12 and her son was killed by the raiding party, whereas, the police has tried to cover up the incident by projecting it as a case of suicide by stating that the son of the petitioner died because he jumped from the 5th floor of the hotel where he was staying. Despite representation dated 15.12.2018 (Annexure P-8) having been submitted, the police has not conducted any inquiry nor has it taken any action against the offending police officials.

Notice of motion to respondents No.2 to 4 only.

Mr. Kirat Singh Sidhu, learned DAG, Punjab accepts notice. Let four copies of the complete paper book be supplied to him during the course of day. Considering the nature of order being passed, no notice is necessary to be issued to respondents No.5 to 12.

The petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.4 to consider this petition as a representation and to take appropriate action thereupon in accordance with law, after hearing the parties concerned, within a period of eight
