This is a petition for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner under Section 438 Cr.P.C. In DDR No.043 dated 24.10.2017 PS City Malout District Shri Muktsar Sahib in FIR No.174 dated 22.10.2017 registered under Sections 324/323/148/149/326 IPC at Police Station City Malout, District Shri Muktsar Sahib.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has argued that as per the allegation the petitioner and other persons had attacked the complainant and his family members. He has further argued that actually it is a cross case where injuries were caused to the petitioner side also. Moreover even though detailed reference has been made in the FIR to the different injuries caused by the different persons no injury has been attributed to the petitioner.

Learned DAG on instructions from H.C. Karnail Singh has accepted these factual assertions.

In the circumstances, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner. Resultantly, the petition is allowed. In the event of arrest of the petitioner, he shall be released on bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating Officer subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petitioner is directed to appear before the Investigating Officer on 01.03.2019 and on any other date as and when his presence is required.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
