Prayer in the instant petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. has been made for issuance of direction to respondents No.1 to 3 to take legal action against respondents No.4 and 5 for giving false complaints and information against the petitioner and further to initiate proceedings under Section 182 IPC against them.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the purpose would be achieved if respondent No.2—Superintendent of Police Sonapat, District Sonapat, is directed to look into representation dated 21.01.2019 (P-1), filed by the petitioner, in a time-bound manner.

Having heard learned counsel for the petitioner and after perusing the paper-book, but without commenting on merits of the case, instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent
