Petitioner Ankit has filed this petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.187 dated 23.03.2018, registered at Police Station Sadar Bahadurgarh, District Jhajjar, Haryana, under Sections 148/149/323/341/506/307/302/120-B of the Indian Penal Code.

Notice of motion was issued.

Learned State counsel has appeared on behalf of the respondent-State and contested this petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and have gone through the record.

From the record, I find that though the present petitioner has been named in the FIR, yet he has been found innocent during the investigation. Now, after the statement of the complainant, the present petitioner has been summoned by the trial Court under Section 319 Cr.P.C..

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that no specific

injury has been attributed to him. As per the FIR, he has not caused any injury to anybody.

Learned State counsel admits that there is no specific attribution to the present petitioner.

In pursuance of the interim order dated 08.02.2019, passed by this Court, the petitioner has already appeared before the trial Court and has been released on interim bail. He is not required for interrogation purposes and simply to face the trial. No useful purpose would be served by sending him to custody.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts of the case in minute details and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, I find merit in this petition and the same is allowed. The order dated 08.02.2019, granting interim bail to the petitioner, is made absolute.
