The grievance of the petitioner is that in respect of the land owned by her husband and father-in-law, the accused persons have obtained sale deeds through coercion and have also taken possession thereof by force without making payment of the entire sale consideration. The sale deeds are under challenge before the civil Court, however, the accused persons are required to be punished for the offence committed by them of obtaining the sale deeds through coercion and intimidation and also by obtaining forcible possession. Although, the police has conducted an enquiry on two earlier occasions, this aspect of the matter has not been enquired into and thus, directions be issued to the police to conduct a proper enquiry.

The petition is disposed of with direction to respondent No.3 to objectively consider the representation dated 4.4.2018 (P6) and reminder dated 9.5.2018 (P7) and to take appropriate action thereupon, in accordance with law, keeping in mind the aforementioned submissions of the learned counsel for the petitioner, within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of

certified copy of this order. The petitioner shall also be at liberty to file additional representation(s) alongwith requisite evidence.
