The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail in respect of case registered vide FIR No.53 dated 12.04.2016, under Section 21 of the NDPS Act, 1985 & Section 42 of Prisoner Act, 1894, registered at Police Station Cantonment and Amritsar.

The allegations in the FIR is that when the petitioner went to meet her husband-Jaimal Singh, who was confined in jail she had supplied 5 grams of *heroin* to her husband as subsequent to her visit, her husband was found in possession of the same.

Pursuant to the interim directions issued on 08.02.2019, the petitioner is stated to have joined investigation as has been informed by learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Davinder Singh.

Bearing in mind the facts and circumstances of the case and also that possibility of procurement of *heroin* by petitioner's husband from some other sources cannot be absolutely ruled out, the petition is accepted and the

interim directions issued on 08.02.2019, are hereby made absolute subject to the condition that the petitioner shall appear and join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and cooperate with the Investigating Officer and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.

The present petition stands accepted accordingly.

It is, however, clarified that none of the observations made above shall be construed to be an expression on merits of the main case.
