This petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 43 dated 12.2.2015 registered under Sections 409 IPC and 13 (3) Prevention of the Corruption Act, 1988 at PS Division No.5, District Ludhiana.

Today affidavit dated 28.3.2019 has been filed by way of affidavit of Sukhchain Singh Gill, IPS, Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana has been filed, the same is taken on record. Copy has been supplied to the opposite counsel. In the affidavit, it has been explained that in which circumstances the petitioner was found innocent. Explanation is accepted.

Coming to the prayer for anticipatory bail, in view of the statement made by the learned DAG (on the last date) that the petitioner has been found innocent, the present petition has rendered infructuous.

Consequently, the petition stands dismissed as infructuous.

Since the main case has been dismissed as infructuous, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands dismissed as such.
