As per pleadings on record, petitioner had been issued a Passport which was valid up to 20.7.2018. Petitioner submitted an application for re-issuance of a Passport on 10.7.2018.

The short grievance raised in the instant petition is that the petitioner thereafter had been called upon to furnish certain clarifications and which was duly responded to on 12.1.2019 and inspite thereof the Passport has not been issued.
