Present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for protection to the life and liberty of the petitioners in view of the marriage solemnized by them against the wishes of respondent Nos.4 to 6.

This Court, in the pre-lunch session of even date, relegated the parties i.e. petitioner No.1 and respondent No.4 to the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court. The parties appeared before the Mediator and got recorded their statements to the effect that they have settled the matter amicably and respondent No.4 (father of girl) assured that he will not interfere in the married life of the petitioners.

In view of above, this Court is satisfied that there is no threat to the life and liberty of the petitioners at present.

In view of above, the present petition is disposed off.

Needless to say that if the occasion so arises, the petitioners would be at liberty to approach this Court again.
