This petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.122 dated 15.12.2018 registered under Sections 420/448/380/506/511/427/148/149-B IPC, 1860 at police station SGN Dev Thermal Plant, District Bhatinda.

As per the FIR, there is dispute between the cousins. As per the allegations the petitioner has forcibly tried to get possession of 3000 sq. Yards and he and his mother sold the land more than their share.

Custody certificate dated 25.2.2019 by way of affidavit of Sukhwinder Singh, PPS, Superintendent Central Jail, Bathinds has been filed on behalf of the respondent-State, the same is taken on record. Copy has been supplied to the opposite counsel. As per the custody certificate the petitioner has been in custody for 2 months.

Without commenting on the merits of the case, keeping in view the above facts and the period of incarceration already suffered by the petitioner, I deem it appropriate to grant regular bail to the petitioner. Ordered accordingly, Bail to the satisfaction of the concerned Trial Court/Duty Magistrate.

Petition stands allowed.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
