Learned counsel for the petitioner, *inter alia* contends that the petitioner has been denied the promotion to the post of Senior Ayurvedic Physician/District Ayurvedic Officer notwithstanding that juniors of the petitioner have been promoted. He further submits that availability of the vacancies to the post of Senior Ayurvedic Physician is not under dispute.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner has neither been given any reasons of his non consideration for promotion nor legal notice caused by him through his counsel has been adverted to.

3. Notice of motion.

4. At the asking of the Court, Ms. Ambika Bedi, AAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the State. Let copy of the petition be supplied to her in course of the day.

5. Given the nature of order being passed, there is no necessity to seek return by any of the respondents as no further proceedings and/or pleadings are required.

6. Writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to consider the legal notice (Annexure P-7) and by keeping in view the contentions stated in the present writ petition by treating it as a supplementary representation and pass a speaking order.

7. Let the needful be done within a period of 3 months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
