It has been averred in the writ petition that the petitioner was engaged by one Rahul to work as a driver on a dumper truck. FIR No.283 dated 08.05.2017 under Section 379 IPC came to be lodged at Police Station, Ratia, District Fatehabad at the instance of Rahul and against an unknown person on the allegations that the dumper truck has been stolen. Counsel submits that name of the petitioner does not even figure in the FIR.

Grievance raised in the instant writ petition is with regard to the illegal detention and high handedness of the police officials concerned of Police Station, Ratia. As per counsel, petitioner was detained by the police authorities for a period of one month i.e. from 08.05.2017 to 06.06.2017 and then again picked up on 08.08.2017 as also on 10.12.2018.

Without ascertaining the correctness of the averments made in the writ petition, I deem it appropriate to dispose of the writ petition with a direction to the Superintendent of Police, Fatehabad/respondent No.3 to

look into the matter against the backdrop of the representation dated 08.09.2018 (Annexure P-2), which is stated to have already been filed and to thereafter take steps as he may deem fit and as mandated in accordance with law.
