Learned counsel for the petitioner states that in respect of the charge-sheet dated 18.05.2015, the petitioner has already been imposed with punishment of recovery. After the said punishment, there are no proceedings pending against the petitioner. The respondent can release the leave encashment after adjusting all the dues, which the petitioner is to pay in respect of the said punishment.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further states that for the relief which has been claimed in the present writ petition, the petitioner has served the respondent with a representation dated 27.10.2018 (Annexure P-7) and the petitioner will be satisfied, at this stage, in case a time bound direction is issued to the respondent to decide the representation dated 27.10.2018 (Annexure P-7) by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Pawan Kumar, Advocate, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent. Copy of the petition be supplied to him. He states that he has

no objection with regard to the prayer made by counsel for the petitioner for disposal of the representation Annexure P-7 in a time bound manner.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case or about the entitlement of the petitioner for the relief which has been claimed by him in the representation dated 27.10.2018 (Annexure P-7), the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondent to decide the representation dated 27.10.2018 (Annexure P-7) within a period of three months from the receipt of certified copy of this order.

In case, it is found that the petitioner is entitled to any monetary benefits after the decision of the representation, the same should also be paid to him within three months thereafter.
