Challenge in the present civil revision petition is against the order dated 15.1.2013 whereby the Land Acquisition Collector, Faridabad (for short, 'the Collector') adjourned the cases *sine die* for want of non-prosecution and as necessary documents were not being supplied. Liberty of restoration on merit on request of the applicants later on was provided.

The grievance raised in the present revision petition is that the petitioner was never served and hence her case has wrongly been adjourned *sine die* with other cases by passing a common order.

Since in the impugned order liberty has already been granted to the parties to get the matter restored, the present revision petition is disposed of with a direction that the grievance raised in the present petition

can be raised before the Collector bringing all the facts to his knowledge.
