The petitioners seek grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.5, dated 17.1.2019, registered under Sections 452, 341, 323, 506, 148, 149, 295 of the IPC, at Police Station Khanauri, District Sangrur.

Allegations are that the petitioners along with co-accused burnt a banner in front of the shop of the complainant and broke window panes of the shop owing to the fact that both the parties had business rivalry.

Counsel for the petitioners states that it is a case of no injury and the main accused has been granted regular bail with whom there was enmity.

Learned DAG Punjab, on instructions from ASI Rameshwar Dass, has accepted these factual assertions.

In these circumstances, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the

concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioners. Consequently, petitioners are directed to appear before the Investigating Officer on 7.3.2019 or on any other day on which the Investigating Officer requires their presence, and in the event of their arrest, the petitioners shall be released on anticipatory bail by the Investigating Officer to his satisfaction subject to the compliance of the provisions as contained in Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.

The petition stands disposed of.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending C.Ms, if any, also stand disposed of.
