The present petition has been filed under Section 439 Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail to petitioner-Sanju @ Sanjeev in case FIR No.57 dated 21.04.2018, registered for the offence punishable under Section 306/34 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 (for short, "IPC"), at Police Station Titram, District Kaithal.

Heard.

The allegations levelled against the petitioner are that on account of begetting no child, the deceased-wife, Gurmeet was being harassed and taunted by the petitioner-husband as well as her mother-in-law and due to this reason, she committed suicide by hanging.

Earlier, petition for bail was dismissed vide order dated 28.09.2018 passed in *CRM-M No.34600-2018*. Thereafter, material witnesses have been examined.

Learned State counsel has apprised this court that out of 17 witnesses, 11 witnesses have been examined.

To the mind of this court, this is a subsequent substance and petitioner is entitled for bail.

Without expressing any opinion on merits of the case and keeping in view the fact that conclusion of trial will take considerably long time, the present petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on furnishing bail bond and surety bond to the satisfaction of trial Court/Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, concerned subject to following terms:-

- (a) The petitioner shall comply with the conditions mentioned in Section 437(3) Cr.P.C.
- (b) In the event of his absence on any date of hearing, the benefit of bail allowed to the petitioner shall stand withdrawn. The trial court shall be competent to cancel his bail bond and surety bond and proceed to procure his presence in accordance with law. In that eventuality the petitioner shall have to apply for bail afresh.
- (c) He shall not leave the country without the previous permission of the court.
