**TEJINDER SINGH DHINDSA, J.(ORAL)**

Petitioner seeks a Mandamus directing the official respondents particularly respondent No.3 to issue to him a Police Clearance Certificate.

Counsel would submit that petitioner had faced trial in certain criminal proceedings and has earned acquittal from the trial court. Appeal against the judgment of acquittal is even though pending but the same would not be an impediment for issuance of a Police Clearance Certificate. It has further been urged that at best the official respondents while issuing the Police Clearance Certificate may recite therein about pendency of the appeal.

On the previous date of hearing a complete copy of the writ paper-book had been furnished to learned State counsel.

State counsel upon instructions from HC Kawaljit Singh,

Police Station Rangarh Nangal, Batala submits that in case the

petitioner appears personally before respondent No.3 and submits an application for issuance of a Police Clearance Certificate, such prayer/request would be processed in accordance with law expeditiously.

Statement made by State counsel is accepted.

In view of the above, no further directions are required to be passed.

Petition disposed of.
