LALIT BATRA, J.

Learned State counsel has placed on record detailed status report by way of affidavit of Sh. Rajinder Singh, Executive Engineer, Public Health Engineering Division, Charkhi Dadri, in terms of which, claims regarding grant of retiral benefits and that too in accordance with revision of pay scales vide Notification dated 1.1.1998, have already been released in favour of the petitioner. Besides that, learned State counsel has placed on record copy of letter dated 6.3.2019, written by petitioner to the Executive Engineer, Public Health Engineering Department, Charkhi Dadri to the effect that since all the pending dues, as claimed in the instant writ petition, have already been released in his favour, petitioner has sought disposal of instant writ petition.

Copies of above said status report as well as letter written by petitioner have been supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner, who in turn submits that since all the pending dues of retiral benefits have already

been released in favour of the petitioner, this writ petition may be disposed of as having become infructuous.

In view of above, instant writ petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.
