Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he had been caused injuries by one Sawan and that the petitioner was medically examined and the MLR (Annexure P-2) indicates receipt of injuries and although the petitioner had made a complaint to the Police (Annexure P-1) but no action had been taken thereupon.
2. Having heard learned counsel for the petitioner, the petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-Commissioner of Police, Gurugram to look into the matter and to dispose of representation (Annexure P-1) expeditiously and in case, the

allegations made therein are found to be well-founded then necessary steps warranted under law be taken thereupon at the earliest.

3. A copy of this order along with copy of the representation (Annexure P-1) and copy of MLR (Annexure P-2) be sent to respondent No.2- Commissioner of Police, Gurugram so as to enable him to do the needful expeditiously.
