ARUN MONGA, J.(ORAL)

The petitioner was charge-sheeted while working as 'Clerk' in respondent No.4-College and pursuant thereto an inquiry was conducted. As per the inquiry report, charges No.1 to 12 were established and, accordingly, the petitioner was indicted. Proposal for his removal was sent by the College Management to respondent No.2. However, the respondent Director Public Instructions (Punjab) declined to accept the proposal of respondent No.4-Management Committee of the College.

2. An appeal under Section 4 of the Punjab Affiliated Colleges (Security of Service of Employees) Act, 1974 before the College Tribunal was filed by respondent No.4 against the order of respondent No.2.

3. The College Tribunal accepted the appeal and pursuant thereto held that the charges No.1 to 12 were rightly established by the Inquiry Officer and it was also held that delinquency attributed to the petitioner qua insubordination and indiscipline was proved.

4. Aggrieved by the order passed by the College Tribunal, present petition has been filed by the petitioner.

5. Order sheet reflects that the petitioner has not been diligently pursuing his cause and has not been represented on various hearings. Even on the last date of hearing, none was present on behalf of the petitioner. Even otherwise, on going through the pleadings and having heard learned counsel for the respondents, I do not find any ground to interfere with the impugned order passed by the College Tribunal.

6. Accordingly, the present writ petition is dismissed.
