The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.05 dated 11.01.2019, under Sections 420 & 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station City Zira, District Ferozepur.

On the last date of hearing, learned counsel for the petitioner had contended that no money had been paid to the petitioner and the entire money, which was allegedly paid by the complainant, was deposited in the account of the co-accused Ranjit Singh.

A coordinate Bench of this Court, by the order dated 15.03.2019, had directed the petitioner to appear before the Investigating Officer and join the investigation and in the event of his arrest, he was to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Gurmeet Singh, states that the petitioner has joined investigation and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the submissions made on the last date of hearing by the learned counsel for the petitioner and the petitioner having joined investigation, the order dated 15.03.2019 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. He shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
