Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.142 dated 23.12.2018 under Sections 420 & 406 IPC, registered at Police Station Ghall Khurd, District Ferozepur.

While granting interim bail to the petitioner, following order was passed by this Court on 15.02.2019 :-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that prior to registration of FIR, a complaint dated 15.12.2017 (Annexure P-2) was given to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Ferozepur, in which the allegations were levelled in similar manner as are levelled in the present FIR. It is further submitted that said complaint was got enquired through DSP (Investigation), Ferozepur, who submitted a report to SP, Ferozepur on 22.02.2018 and in that enquiry, present complainant Sonu also recorded his statement along with Lakhvinder Singh and it was

found that a sum of Rs.90,000/- was given by Suba Singh to Gurpreet Singh for his visa and the fact regarding payment for sending Sonu or Lakhwinder Singh abroad, by the petitioner or Suba Singh was not proved. Learned counsel further submits that on the same set of allegations, now the present FIR has been registered.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Pritam Chand, submits that there are no direct allegations against the petitioner and the allegations are against husband of the petitioner Suba Singh, however, submitted that the petitioner be directed to join the investigation.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in pursuance of the aforesaid order, petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for any further investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from HC Hardeep Singh, has not disputed the factual position and states that the petitioner is no more required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, this petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 15.02.2019 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
