Through the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., prayer has been made for seeking anticipatory bail to petitioners – Harphool Singh and Jagtar Singh, in case FIR No. 81, dated 30.08.2018, registered under Sections 420/465/467/468/471/120-B IPC, at Police Station Sadar, Kotkapura, District Faridkot.

Vakalatnama on behalf of the complainant filed in Court today, though he has not been impleaded, is taken on record. Office to tag the same at appropriate place.

On instructions from HC Laxman Singh, learned State counsel submits that petitioners have joined the investigation and are no more required for interrogation.

Learned counsel for the complainant opposed the petition.

Heard learned counsel for the parties.

Since, the Investigating Agency does not require the petitioner any more for investigation, therefore, contention of the learned counsel for the complainant is rejected.

Having considered the facts and circumstances of the case, order dated 11.02.2019 passed by this Court, is made absolute.
