Special leave to appeal has been sought against the judgment passed by the Court of Sessions acquitting respondent.

Learned appellate court has dismissed the complaint by recording as under:-

- (1) *No specific date, month or year on which the amount of Rs.3,00,000/- was lent has been disclosed.*
- (2) *Complainant has admitted that he used to run a small shop in his house and he is not even income tax payee. Although, he claimed that he had withdrawn Rs.3,00,000/- deposited from his account from the bank, however, failed to disclose the name of the bank or account number.*
- (3) *Son of the complainant was engaged as a counsel by the accused.*

The learned court had taken a reasonable and probable view which is not shown to be suffering from any perversity or material irregularity or illegality.

Hence, no ground to grant special leave to appeal is made out.

Dismissed.
