GURVINDER SINGH GILL, J. (ORAL)

1. The petitioner seeks quashing of FIR No.73 dated 6.8.2015 under Sections 379 & 411 IPC, Police Station Phase No.8, SAS Nagar and proceedings emanating therefrom on the basis of a compromise having been effected between the parties.
2. Vide order dated 6.3.2019 the parties had been directed to appear before the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate so as to get the statements recorded with regard to the genuineness of the compromise.
3. Report of learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, SAS Nagar, Mohali

has been received wherein it has been reported that statements of the petitioner as well as of complainant-Ratinder Singh Sodhi have been recorded who have stated that they have compromised the matter and that complainant has no objection if the FIR is quashed. It has specifically been opined by learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, SAS Nagar, Mohali that the compromise between the parties is genuine and valid and without any coercion or undue influence from any corner.

4. In view of the aforesaid compromise and bearing in mind the law laid down by Full Bench of this Court in 2007(3) RCR (Crl.) 1052 Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab, the petition is allowed and FIR No.73 dated 6.8.2015 under Sections 379 & 411 IPC, Police Station Phase No.8, SAS Nagar and all the consequent proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed qua the petitioner.
