Prayer in this petition is for issuance of direction to respondent Nos. 1 to 4 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner from the threats and harassment being caused by respondent No. 4 at the instance of respondent Nos. 5 to 12.

Reply, by way of affidavit of Assistant Commissioner of Police, East, Amritsar, is filed in Court today. As per this reply, the petitioner has appeared before ASI Rajwinder Singh, Police Station B-Division, Amritsar City and has made a statement that for the last two years, he is residing in Amritsar and none of the persons, named in the statement i.e. private respondents in this petition, or the police from Police Station Kot Mit Singh has come to his home and the police has never called him. The petitioner has further stated that he has no issue with the Amritsar Police. It is further stated in the reply that since the complaint (Annexure P-2) given by the

petitioner pertains to Tarn Taran, the same has been forwarded to S.S.P., Tarn Taran for taking further action.

In view of the same, this petition is disposed of as infructuous.

However, liberty is granted to petitioner to approach the S.S.P., Tarn Taran for redressal of his grievances.
