The petitioner has preferred the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., for grant of pre-arrest bail in case FIR No.206 dated 11.11.2018, registered under Sections 354, 323, 148, 149 IPC at Police Station Islamabad, District Amritsar (P-1).

Learned counsel for the petitioner has been submitted that both the parties have suffered injuries.

Learned State counsel has stated that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is no more required for custodial interrogation.

In the circumstances, without going into the merits of the case, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in the present case.

Resultantly, the interim order dated 13.02.2019 is made absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands allowed.

The petitioner is directed to pay of Rs.10,000/- by way of bank draft as interim compensation to the victim. The said amount shall be

without prejudice to the rights of the parties subject to the outcome of the trial.

The said amount shall be tendered before the Magistrate within a period of 10 days who shall handed over the same to the victim within 15 days from the date of the receipt of the copy of this order.
