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RAMENDRA JAIN , J . (Oral)

Prayer in the instant petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. has been made for quashing FIR No.135 dated 27.11.2018, registered under Sections 326, 323 and 506 read with Section 34 IPC, at Police Station Ramdas, District Amritsar Rural and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of compromise.

Pursuant to order dated 12.02.2019 of this Court, the parties appeared before the trial Court on 09.05.2019 along with receipts of ₹15,000/- to get their statements recorded. Learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Ajnala, has submitted his report vide letter bearing No.145 dated 15.05.2019 duly forwarded by learned District and Sessions Judge, Amritsar, vide Endst. No. 4707R dated 16.05.2019.

According to the report, learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Ajnala, is satisfied that the compromise is genuine, valid and without any pressure or coercion in any manner. No accused has been declared as proclaimed offender.

Considering the report of learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Ajnala, dated 15.5.2019 and the fact that the compromise will bring peace and harmony in relations between the parties, aforesaid FIR No.135 dated 27.11.2018 along with all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, is quashed qua the petitioners only.

Disposed of accordingly.
