In the present writ petition, the prayer of the petitioner is for deciding the departmental appeal which the petitioner had filed on 29.08.2016 (Annexure P-3) against the order dated 12.05.2016 (Annexure P-2) vide which punishment of 10% deduction in pension for a period of five years was imposed upon the petitioner.

As per the averments made in the writ petition, the said appeal is still pending consideration despite elapse of approximately more than two years despite the fact that the petitioner had given reminders dated 03.12.2018 and 17.12.2018 (Annexure P-4) (Colly).

Without going into the merits of the case or expressing any opinion to the entitlement of the petitioner in respect of the claim prayed in the present writ petition or in the appeal, the present writ petition is disposed of with a

direction to the respondents to pass an appropriate speaking order on the claim raised by the petitioner in the appeal dated 29.08.2016 (Annexure P-3) within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

The writ petition stands disposed of.
