Notice of motion.

On the asking of court, Ms.Anu Chatrath, Addl.A.G.,Punjab accepts notice on behalf of official respondents.

Petitioner has impugned orders Annexures P/6 & P/8 whereby its plea for grant of stage carriage permit was rejected. A perusal of order passed by appellate tribunal, however, shows that petitioner was granted liberty to apply afresh as per new scheme i.e Punjab Transport Scheme 2018.

On a query being put to learned State counsel in this regard, she submits that in case petitioner is eligible and apply afresh, its case would be considered by State Transport Commissioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner is satisfied with the aforesaid statement. He, however, prays that fresh applications, if any, be decided within a fixed time frame. This court finds the prayer reasonable.

Petition is disposed of with a direction that in case petitioner is eligible and apply afresh for grant of stage carriage permit, its plea shall be decided at the earliest in any case not later than 3 months if maintainable.
