The petitioner seeks grant of regular bail in case FIR No.88, dated 7.4.2018, registered under Sections 148, 149, 341, 323, 379B, 325, 506 of the IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act, at Police Station Adampur, District Hisar.

Counsel for the petitioner states that similarly situated co-accused have already been granted bail by this Court vide order dated 15.12.2018 passed in CRM-M No.43359 of 2018 and dated 7.2.2019 passed in CRM-M No.4603 of 2019, and that the petitioner has now been in custody for more than nine months.

Custody certificate has been placed on record, as per which the petitioner has undergone 9 months and 1 day of custody. Though there are

other cases pending against him but he is not a convict in any other case.

Learned DAG Punjab, on instructions from ASI Harjinder Singh, has accepted that the role of all the co-accused is similar.

In these circumstances, without commenting upon the merits of the case, and keeping in view the period of custody already suffered by the petitioner as well as the fact that similarly situated co-accused have already been granted the benefit of regular bail, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.

Petition stands disposed of.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending C.Ms, if any, also stand disposed of.
