Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.573 dated 28.07.2017, registered at Police Station Civil Lines, Gurugram, District Gurugram, under Sections 302, 394, 397, 120-B and 34 of the IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959.

Notice of motion was issued. Learned State counsel has appeared on behalf of respondent-State and complainant has also appeared through her counsel. They contested this petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties as well as learned State counsel and gone through the record.

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Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that there is no evidence against the present petitioner.

Learned State counsel has brought to the notice of this Court that case is at preliminary stage and examination-in-chief of one witness has been recorded.

Perusal of FIR shows that the present petitioner is named in the FIR and motive is also against him. As regarding the fact that there is no evidence against him, I find that charges have already been framed against him, as stated by learned State counsel.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; in view of nature and gravity of the offence and in view of the facts that case is at preliminary stage and if the bail is granted to the petitioner, there is every chance of tampering with the evidence, I do not find it a fit case where the petitioner is entitled to the benefit of regular bail.

Therefore, finding no merit in the present petition, the same is dismissed.
