The present petition has been filed by the petitioners under Section 438 Cr.P.C for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.67 dated 24.05.2016 registered under Sections 302, 323, 435, 427, 148, 149 IPC at Police Station Talwandi Sabo, District Bathinda.

Counsel for the petitioners has submitted that while filing challan, although it was written that if any evidence comes up against them then challan will be filed against them as well, however, the further investigation carried out by the Deputy Superintendent of Police had found them to be innocent. It is further contended by the counsel that since, at this stage, petitioners stand summoned by the Court, therefore, subject to their availing further remedies in accordance with law, the petitioners intend to appear before the Court. The only prayer is that they be protected against their arrest.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Rajat Bansal, AAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the State. He has no objection if the petitioners appear before the Court to face further proceedings in accordance with law.

In view of the above, but without commenting upon merits of the case, any further, the present petition is allowed. The petitioners are directed to appear before the trial Court on or before 25.02.2019. It is further ordered that in case the petitioners so appears before the trial Court, then they shall be released on bail pending trial on their furnishing bonds/ sureties to the satisfaction of the trial Court/ Duty Magistrate.
