Petitioner Inderjeet Singh Walia has preferred the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.p.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.142 dated 30.11.2018, registered under Sections 406, 498-A, 506 IPC, at Police Station Women Cell, Ludhiana, Punjab.

This court, vide order dated 25.02.2019 directed the petitioner to pay Rs.25,000/- as litigation expenses to complainant Smt. Mamta Dhawan, which has not been paid to her.

It has been submitted that the petitioner is unable to pay the said amount.

The serious allegations have been levelled against the petitioner with regard to beating and for bringing less dowry. Even her *istridhan* articles have not been returned to her.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the case, this court is of the opinion that the petitioner is not entitled for the concession of anticipatory bail.

In view of aforesaid discussion, the instant petition stands dismissed.
