ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.347 dated 23.06.2016, under Sections 307/387/420/34 IPC and Sections 25/54/59 of the Arms Act, registered at Police Station Samalkha, District Panipat.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the allegations in the FIR are that a young boy had fired a shot on the complainant which hit him on his thigh. The young boy was allegedly identified as the petitioner. The complainant has fully recovered and has not supported the prosecution case qua the petitioner in his deposition before the trial Court. The petitioner is in custody since 2 years and 10 months. The co-accused namely Kismat has been granted regular bail by the coordinate Bench of this Court in CRM-M-15670-2018 on 24.04.2018.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions states that 5 prosecution witnesses have been examined and all of them have not supported the prosecution case.

Heard.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner especially when the petitioner is in custody for over 2 years and 10 months and the co-accused has been granted regular bail, I deem it a fit case to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
