In the present writ petition, the grievance raised by the petitioner is that the service benefit for the period when he remained in Indian Army during national emergency, has not been given to him despite the fact that he was fully eligible.

As per the averments made in the writ petition, the petitioner is claiming that his case is squarely covered by the judgment passed by this Court in CWP No. 3489 of 1994, decided on 18.08.1997(Annexure P-9). For the relief, which has been claimed in the present writ petition, the petitioner has made representations dated 08.07.2017 and 27.10.2018 (Annexure P-7) (Colly) and as per the averments made in the writ petition, the said representations are still pending consideration with the respondents.

Without going into the merits of the case or expressing any

opinion to the entitlement of the petitioner in respect of the claim prayed in the present writ petition or in the representations, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to pass an appropriate speaking order on the claim raised by the petitioner in the representations dated 08.07.2017 and 27.10.2018 (Annexure P-7) (Colly) within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

In case after the order, it is found by the respondents that the petitioner is entitled for any monetary benefits, the same should also be released to him within a period of next three months.

The writ petition stands disposed of.
