Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that earlier the petitioner was released on bail and there was a compromise before the *panchayat*. The petitioner went to abroad and P.O proceedings were initiated at his back but he has not been declared as a proclaimed offender. Learned counsel also submits that co-accused have been acquitted of the charge by the trial Court vide judgment dated 08.08.2012. Petitioner after coming to India had come to know about the proceedings. He is ready to join investigation and to surrender before the trial Court.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Ms. Bhavna Gupta, D.A.G., Punjab, who is present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State.

In view of submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioner, in case, the petitioner surrenders before the trial Court within a period of one week from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order and moves an application for regular bail, the trial Court is directed to

consider the same, if so filed and take necessary action thereupon in accordance with law within a period of one week thereafter.

The petition is disposed of accordingly.
