The petitioners allege that on being enticed by the accused persons money was paid to them to send their sons to Europe. Their sons have reached Europe but more money is being demanded to keep them there. It is further alleged that the accused persons are illegally running an immigration racket and their sons are in danger. A representation dated 30.01.2019 (Annexure P-6) has been submitted but no action has been taken thereupon by the police.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Luvinder Sofat, AAG Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondents. Let five copies of the petition be supplied to him during the course of the day.

Considering the nature of the order being passed, there is no necessity to seek reply.

The petition is disposed of with direction to respondent No. 2 to objectively consider the representation dated 30.01.2019 (Annexure P-6) and to take appropriate action thereupon in accordance with law, in case it is felt necessary, within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
