This petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of direction to respondents No.1 to 3 to take action against respondents No.4 & 5 mentioned in FIR No.0070 dated 23.10.2018, registered under Sections 341/323/324/506/34 IPC on the basis of MLR Report, registered at Police Station Mullanpur Garibdass, District SAS Nagar Mohali and also to transfer the investigation of above mentioned FIR to Crime Branch (CIA).

Counsel for the petitioner states that in this connection the petitioner has also moved a representation dated 20.12.2018 (Annexure P-4) and at this stage he would be satisfied if a direction is given to respondent No.2 – Superintendent of Police, SAS Nagar, Mohali, District Mohali to look into the matter and take appropriate action on his representation within any reasonable time.

I find this to be a fair request. The respondent No.2 is directed to look into the matter and in case it is found that any action is required, to take whatever action he deems necessary as per law within a period of two weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

Petition stands disposed of in the above terms.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
