Present case was set in motion with the allegations that previously accused had lodged a false criminal case against him wherein he had stated that he is of the belief that the complainant in this case was the person behind the attack on the accused by filing a complaint under Sections 500/34 of the Indian Penal Code with allegations that the complainant has been defamed. It is not disputed that on the application of the appellant, he was discharged as the police did not raise any objection. Still further, the Court on appreciation of evidence has found that there is no cogent evidence to prove the case against the accused.

Although, learned counsel for the applicant has made sincere attempt, however, failed to establish that there was any perversity or substantive misreading of the evidence. Hence, there is no ground to grant leave to file appeal.

Accordingly, present application for grant of leave to file appeal is dismissed.
