Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.74 dated 20.04.2017 under Sections 419, 420, 465, 467, 468, 471, 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station City Phagwara, District Kapurthala.

While granting interim bail to the petitioner, following order was passed by this Court on 14.02.2019 :-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that co-accused of the petitioner, namely, Hem Raj filed CRM-M No.25721 of 2017 and he has been released on interim bail on his depositing an amount of Rs.1,51,140/-, which has subsequently been made absolute. The case is based on documentary evidence and nothing is to be

recovered from the petitioner. He is ready to join investigation....”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in pursuance of the aforesaid order, petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for any further investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Baljinder Singh, has not disputed the factual position and states that the petitioner is no more required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, this petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 14.02.2019 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
