Special Leave to Appeal has been sought against judgment of acquittal passed by the learned Judicial Magistrate while dismissing the complaint filed under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act, 1881.

It has been found by the Magistrate that the Bank Account No.5135 is in the name of "Seema Industries" through Seema Suri, the sole proprietor. Cheque No.955841 dated 10.07.2011 amounting to ₹3,40,0000/- drawn on Canara Bank, The Mall, Amritsar, is from account No.5135. Thus, bank account in question is not of respondent.

Learned counsel for the applicant/appellant does not dispute to the correctness of the aforesaid findings. Hence, there is no perversity or substantive error.

Accordingly, special leave to appeal is declined.

In view of the order passed on merits in application for grant of special leave to appeal, no order is required to be passed in application for condonation of delay.
